We look forward to the visit of Rev Colin Pye, Regional Baptist Minister, who is coming to preach on Sunday November 4th and then lead us in Communion (Baptist style).

The following Sunday, 11th November, as it will be exactly 100 years since the end of the 1st World War and therefore a very special Remembrance Sunday we are going to do something very different and hopefully reach out into the community. We will meet first on Park Square at 10.45am for an Act of Remembrance leading up to the 2 minute silence at 11am. We will then parade back to church where we will have a short-all age service followed by refreshments. The Guides, Brownies and Rainbows who use our church building on a Friday opening have expressed a keen desire to join with us, and with some posters around the estate we hope others from the community may join us too. We are ordering some attractive booklets called "Silence" which have been specially produced for the 100th anniversary which can be given away to guests and others. Please pray that the Lord will touch different hearts and lives through all that takes place.

After a three week break we will restart The Bible Course on Sunday 18th November and do the final 4 sessions. As before we start each session during the Sunday morning service looking at the DVD and having discussions around tables. We then continue with the 2nd part of each session during midweek.
